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Collaborative International Online Learning COIL

COIL står for *Collaborative Online International Learning*, og er en internationalt udbredt undervisningsmetode, som har til formål at **understøtte digitale interaktioner** mellem studerende **på tværs af lande**. Ambitionen er at etablere **et digitalt samarbejde mellem studerende** omkring et udvalgt fagområde og samtidigt styrke studerendes internationale udsyn og deres interkulturelle og digitale kompetencer (Villar-Onrubia & Rajpal 2015).

Termen **virtuel mobilitet** har også været anvendt i forbindelse med COIL-projekter for at tydeliggøre, at der er tale om **internationale interaktioner muliggjort via teknologi frem for interaktioner muliggjort gennem fysiske møder** (Sweeney 2014: 9)



Case: UCN-UAlbany COIL Project on Educational Systems

Participants: 36 students from MS Childhood Education at SUNY University of Albany. 45 BA students from UCN

Goal: Working online in small groups, students from both institutions will examine each other's education systems and use the comparison of both systems to better understand the role of cultural context in shaping educational ideas and practices

Duration: 6 weeks

Form: Asynchronous discussion board on TEAMS, however some students chose to conduct a synchronous video call

Progression of a COIL module

COIL structure:

1. **Introductory Videos:**

Students from both UAlbany and UCN will create brief (3-5 minute) individual videos in which they introduce themselves, discuss their beliefs about education, and share their experiences as students in their country's education system.

2. ***Sharing Experiences and Comparing Education Systems:***

Working in small groups of 4-6 students (from both UAlbany and UCN), students will share their videos on an asynchronous discussion board and, using the videos as a starting point, engage in an online discussion about the main features of their country's education system and the main challenges facing education today in their country, culminating in a brief collaborate statement.

3. **Reflection:**

Each student will write a brief reflection focusing on what they learned from this project about their country's education system and about education in general.

Hvad siger de studerende?

Ghana: "I've learned that other cultures are different, and that our approaches to project work like this (the COIL) also differ across borders. But I have learned how one can handle such situations, and I have become better in how I react on such issues myself. I have been forced to communicate in English, which is not my strong side, but it was good for me."

Japan: "We learned how to communicate with people we don't know in the correct formal way. Also, I take away from the COIL project that things does not always succeed."

UAlbany: "The best interaction I had were the questions related to my experience and the ability to truly reflect on my own and come up with detailed enough responses to assist my group members in Denmark, I believe the self-reflection is what truly makes the project shine."

"In the case of this COIL project, reflection is thinking about the structure of education. What seems 'normal' to me in the United States may not be 'normal' in Denmark, and this project has allowed me to reflect on that."




